Summer 2025 Second Half Term



English	Mathematics
The children will have the opportunity to write a discussion text with reasons for and against deforestation of the Amazon Rainforest. Following this they will create a non-chronological report where they will research their chosen subject and will present their findings in the form of a report which they can present to their classmates. We will be consolidating all the work previously studied in our grammar lessons.	The children will be working on 'money matters' maths. They will be focusing on a project that will cover annual salaries, hourly rates, bills, mortgages, and how to manage owning your own home. We will continue our daily arithmetic lessons and begin to look at transitional maths into high school.
Art & Design	Computing
In art lessons, we will be doing monochromatic arts based around detailed sketching. The pupils will learn about proportions and shape to sketch a detailed eye, lips and nose in preparation for drawing a complete facial portrait.	As well as completing our digital art project from last term, the pupils will be exploring advances in new technology and the impact (both positive and negative) this has on society. We will research and explore how technology may change in the future.
Design & Technology	Geography
The focus for our DT fortnight will be <i>Playgrounds</i> . We will be researching the different types of playgrounds from around the world and looking at how we can design, plan, and build our own replica playgrounds using a wide range of methods to stiffen, strengthen and reinforce the different structures.	We have completed all the geography units for this academic year. Last half term we focussed on fieldwork skills which fed into our trip to High Borrans. The children also learnt about the different biomes of the world and the features, similarities and differences of these areas.
History	Music
The pupils will be focusing on World War Two and in particular the Battle of Britain. Throughout this topic, we we learn about how and why the war started and the efforts of the Allied Forces to stop the Nazi regime. The pupils will research facts and produce the findings in a number of ways about the crucial part of British history.	We will be learning songs for our leaver's assembly. We will also be learning to sign a song as well as playing some musical instruments for the end of year event.
Personal Social Health & Economic education (PSHE)	Physical Education (PE)
The pupils will be learning about how a baby develops from conception. We will be looking how feelings develop when becoming a teenager as well as discussing our feelings around leaving Primary School and moving on to High School.	The children will attend a residential at High Borrans in The Lake District. In lessons, the children will be developing their athletics skills in preparation for sports day. We also have cricket coaches to work with the pupils one lesson per week.
Religious Education (RE)	Science
This unit of work will explore the place religion has in the world today. We will investigate and discuss different world views of religion and consider the importance of religious freedom and how religion can make better people in the future.	This half term, the pupils will be strengthening their science skills by completing a range of various investigations. This be provide opportunities to explore a number of concepts scientifically including UV lessons and safety of sunglasses.
In KS2 we learn French in our Modern Foreign Languages Curriculum (MFL)	
The children will be revising previous units of work including colours, numbers, greetings and school life. We will also be learning about the countries in the world that speak French as well as festivals that happen in France.
