

Richardson Dees Primary School Travel Plan

Aim

The aim of this document is to aid sustainable travel to Richardson Dees Primary School, therefore reducing traffic around the school. Location

Richardson Dees Primary School (NE28 7RT) is situated on High Street East (A193), Wallsend. Burnside College and Hadrian Leisure Centre are just to the north-east and Wallsend town centre is to the west.


Cycling and Walking
