

How we embed British Values into our Art Curriculum

Democracy

Children vote on class design choices (e.g., colour schemes, themes for a mural).

Pupils take part in group projects where they discuss and agree roles or artistic decisions.

We highlight that art encourages considering others' views when working collaboratively.

Individual Liberty

Children choose materials, techniques, or themes within a project.

Sketchbooks are used as a safe space for experimentation and creative risk-taking.

We promote that art supports freedom of expression and personal creativity.

Mutual Respect & Tolerance

Pupils study artists from a range of cultures and faiths.

Peer evaluation sessions allow pupils to give constructive, respectful feedback.

Rule of Law

Teachers can set clear expectations for how materials and equipment are used; reinforcing that rules help keep everyone safe and ensure equal opportunities to participate.
