Democracy

Our pupils are taught that their opinions matter and that everyone has the right to be heard respectfully, both offline and online. Our staff model safe and respectful online communication and provide opportunities for pupils to contribute ideas through class discussions, pupil voice activities, and collaborative digital projects.

Individual Liberty

Our online safety curriculum empowers pupils to make independent and safe choices when using technology. Our pupils develop confidence in making decisions that protect their wellbeing and personal safety. Our children are encouraged to develop resilience and critical thinking skills so they can safely navigate digital environments.

Mutual Respect & Tolerance

Staff ensure that respect is consistently promoted throughout all online interactions and digital learning opportunities. We teach our children that respectful behaviour applies equally in both online and offline spaces. Staff encourage pupils to celebrate positive online behaviour and responsible digital citizenship.

Rule of Law

Pupils are taught that rules help keep everyone safe online, just as they do in school and society. Staff reinforce clear expectations for safe technology use throughout the school day. Children are introduced, in an age-appropriate way, to the fact that some online behaviours are unsafe or against the law.
