Democracy

Children are encouraged to share their ideas and explain their thinking during mathematical activities. Group problem-solving promotes discussion, collaboration, and respect for others' contributions.

Individual Liberty

Mathematics allows children to explore, investigate, and make choices in their learning. They are supported to develop their own strategies and approaches, building independence and confidence.

Mutual Respect & Tolerance

Children learn to value different ways of thinking and solving problems. They are encouraged to listen to others' ideas and recognise that there can be multiple solutions.

Rule of Law

Mathematical activities support an understanding of order, pattern, and sequence. Children learn to follow processes and recognise that rules help ensure consistency and fairness.
