Democracy

Children are encouraged to make choices, share their opinions, and take part in group decision-making. Opportunities to express preferences help them understand that their views are important and valued.

Individual Liberty

We provide children with opportunities to develop independence, make choices, and take responsibility for their actions. This supports their understanding of personal freedom within safe boundaries.

Mutual Respect & Tolerance

Through positive relationships and adult modelling, children learn to respect others, show kindness, and understand different perspectives. They are supported to appreciate similarities and differences between themselves and others.

Rule of Law

Children develop an understanding of rules, routines, and boundaries. They learn about right and wrong, fairness, and the consequences of their actions, helping them feel secure within the setting.
