Democracy

Children are encouraged to share their experiences and talk about their understanding of the world. They learn to listen to others and recognise that people may have different perspectives.

Individual Liberty

Children are supported to develop a sense of self and identity. They are encouraged to make choices and explore their interests, helping them understand their place in the world.

Mutual Respect & Tolerance

Through learning about different cultures, communities, and traditions, children develop an appreciation of diversity. They learn to respect and celebrate differences between people.

Rule of Law

Children learn about rules within their environment and the wider world. They begin to understand why rules are important and how they help people live safely and harmoniously.
