Breakfast Club 2026-27

We are delighted that for yet another year, we are able to offer our fantastic FREE Breakfast Club *from Monday 7th September 2026*.

- The FREE Breakfast Club offer is available to ALL children from Year 1 to Year 6
- All pupils who wish to attend Breakfast Club must first have our 'Breakfast Club Behaviour Contract' via a Google Form (see link at end of letter).

There are some other things you might need to know about how Breakfast Club works.

- Breakfast Club takes place in our school hall and is accessed by the main entrance.
- Doors open from 8.00 am and the final breakfast serving is at 8.30 am.
- Children are provided with a range of breakfast options including milk, juice, water, yoghurt, cereal, toast and fruit and some other additional treats.
- Activities are organised for them in the hall. If they prefer, children can just sit and talk with their friends and school staff. When the weather is nice they can play outside.
- Children can attend as and when they wish. If certain days work better for families or just occasionally attending Breakfast Club is a help, then that is fine. Equally children can come every day if they wish.
- We have *never* gone over capacity but if we did we would draft in other staff to help out.

If you do have any questions, as ever just contact school and we will be happy to help.





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I accept that in order for my child to be allowed to attend Breakfast Club, they must behave appropriately at all times and that all children :

- Are polite and kind to other pupils and staff at all times
- Follow instructions given to them by staff whenever they are asked to
- Respect the resources that are provided to make Breakfast Club even more fun for them
- Move calmly around the hall – it is not safe to run around in the hall during Breakfast Club
- Never act in manner that could be unsafe for them or others

If your child is unable to meet the expectations above on any occasion, school will contact parents / carers to discuss what improvements in their choices are needed.

In the event that inappropriate behaviour should continue from that point, children WILL lose their place at Breakfast Club for a period of time that will be decided by school.
